Mr. and Mrs. Glenn Lewis, 1004 West Kansas Ave., of Midland, announce the approaching marriage of their daughter, Jean, to Robert G. Peter of Houston, son of Mrs. Robert J. Peter of Giddings.

The wedding will take place at a small, informal ceremony in the Trinity Episcopal Church on April 2nd, with the Rev. R. Matthew Lynn, pastor of the First Presbyterian Church, conducting the service.

Miss Lewis attended Midland schools, graduating from Midland High School in 1939. She received her degree in geology from the University of Texas in 1944. After graduation, she was employed as a geologist in Midland by the Superior Oil Company and by the Permian Basin Sample Laboratory.

She returned to the University of Texas from 1946 to 1948 as an instructor in the Department of Geology while fulfilling the academic requirements for a Masters Degree. Miss Lewis is a member of Phi Beta Kappa and Sigma XI.

Mr. Peter attended University of Texas from 1940 to 1944, when he received his commission as ensign in the United States Navy, serving in the Pacific campaign. After his discharge with the rank of lieutenant, jg, he returned to the University of Texas and received his degree in mechanical engineering in 1947.
