Mrs. C. M. Bishop. Dear Friend:

I am well, hope the same of you. Sorry I have not written sooner, but I haven't had much time to myself and when I am off I have a thousand and one things I want to do. The people back home have a lot to learn abount living under war conditions, and give up a lot more than just cars, gas and tires.

I have seen some beautiful places and sights in Africa. Egypt and here in Palestine. The names of the cities will be best not to say. I intend to see a lot more of this country while I am over here.

Mr. Wendell Wilkie was by to see us the other day. He stayed about an hour, then took off again. He said American boys are doing a swell job across the ocean.

Tell everyone hello for me. They just started paying off so I will close. To sum this all up, this is still the Promised Land.
